

Installing the Ayrstone AyrMesh™ Hub as a Gateway



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Before you start...

You should have the following items:

- 1.) Ayrstone AyrMesh Hub with short Ethernet cable
- 2.) Long Ethernet Cable (purchased separately)




Note: Ethernet cables come in a variety of colors; the color of the cable has no meaning at all. The cables you use may be any color




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Step 1: Get an account on Ayrmesh.com

- Using a computer attached to the same router you're going to put the AyrMesh hub on, use a browser to go to <http://www.ayrmesh.com>
- Click on the "No username? Sign up now – it's free!" link
- Fill in the form as indicated – make sure you provide a working email address (don't worry – we are not going to "spam" you)

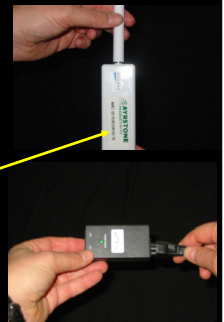

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Step 2: Assemble

- Open the box; take the protector off the AyrMesh Hub and screw on the antenna (carefully!)
- Write down the MAC address from the Ayrstone label on the Hub – keep someplace safe.
- Assemble the Power Supply by plugging the power cord into the black box.



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Step 3: Test everything

- Slide open the cover & connect the AyrMesh Hub to the "POE" port of the Power Supply with one ethernet cable
- Connect the "LAN" port of the Power Supply to your router with another ethernet cable
- Plug in the power supply; verify that the two bottom lights on the Hub light up
- Verify that the Hub "checks in" to the AyrMesh Portal



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Step 4: Mount the AyrMesh Hub

- Take mounting clip off the Hub
- Use screws to attach clip to flat surface, or use zip-ties to attach Hub to mast or pole
- If using the clip, snap the Hub back onto the clip



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Step 5: Run the cable

- Plug one end of the ethernet cable into the Hub and put the "door" back on
- Run the cable to the Power Supply and plug into the "POE" port
- Run the other cable from the "LAN" port of the Power Supply into your router or switch



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Step 6: Finish Up

- Plug in the power supply
- Make sure Hub's lights are on (bottom 2)
- Make sure Hub checks into Ayrmesh.com
- You're done!



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
